On behalf of Clubs Nowa's Board of Directors, I present the 2026 annual report. The Board with our highly motivated management and staff continues to work very hard on your behalf. The Club continues to confront cost of living pressures, industry reforms and ongoing Government compliance.

The Board and Management focus on improving our members and guests experience whilst supporting ongoing growth and sustainability.

The revenue and outcomes for financial year 2025 are as follows:

1. Trading profit of \$231,156.00
2. Loss after depreciation \$50,804.00

Increases in items which affected this year's outcomes are as follows:

- Club house Repairs up 57.00%
- Greens Labour up 16.30%
- Cost of Sales up \$54K
- Electricity up 19.4%
- Wages & Oncosts up 50K
